Professionally refretted recently and lots of honest wear and tear on the finish, typical of a pre-war era Gibson. We are approximating the date due to the illegible production number stamp but estimate within two years. I observe loose end on the second back strut but back is solid and no sign of movement. Could be glued but probably been that way for 60 years or more and back is very stable and solid. Grant MacNeill
